# SEE the HEART of GOD

Keep the conversation going...

The word *happy* is rooted in the Greek word for *happenstance*, or *surroundings and circumstances*. How does blessing differ from happiness? Tell someone about a genuine blessing you've received.

The nature of a tree is to mature and bear fruit. What are some reasons a tree might fail to produce fruit or multiply? How do those reasons apply to a Christian's life? What ways can a follower of Christ improve their fruitfulness?

Some trees are planted intentionally. Their location and spacing are purposeful and in line with their future use. Some grow and mature where the seeds randomly fall. Each has a role to play and have purpose. Is either one more or less valuable than the other? How might this apply to your current circumstances? Do you sense purpose where you are and with what you're doing?
