Checking In

Discovery Questions

- How have you conformed to this world and what is a step you can take to move toward being more like Jesus over that conformity?
- Where has your will replaced His will? Be transparent. How has this affected your relationships with others? How can you be more intentional about making a change?
- Discuss 1 Corinthians 2: 14-16. What does this mean in your life? How do you discern through the Holy Spirit?

Putting It Into Practice

Each week Pastor Scott will challenge you to put into practice what you are learning. These challenges will help you take the concepts we are learning deeper into your life and help you with your own personal hope. This week Pastor Scott challenges us to:

1. Renew through relationships
Go to those relationships that need to be renewed and thus renewing yourself as well.
2. Renew your worship
Intentionally renew through acts of worship this week. What is a new way where you can not exert your will but conform to His will? Use this

concept in your group throughout the week to support one another on our journey and to do life together. Your group benefits from your presence and your input is valuable. Commit to one another.

3. Knowing the will of God

Seek to learn how to discern the will of God in your life. Seek some resources or wisdom from others that will help you understand this discernment. This is one of the most common questions: How to discern His will in your life?
