Discovery Questions

- Have you ever felt that God spoke to you about something that you thought would be impossible?
- We are reminded over and over again through scripture that we should trust God. Is it “easy” or “hard” for you to trust God when you are not in control?
- Often times we want to second guess what God is saying to us. Do not allow fear to rule over your decision to follow. What do you fear most that God may ask you do?
- Is it OK with you that God does something different than what you have planned?

Putting It Into Practice

Each week Pastor Scott will challenge you to put into practice what you are learning. These challenges will help you take the concepts we are learning deeper

into your life and help you with your own personal hope. This week Pastor Scott challenges us to:

1. When God Speaks

When God speaks to you, you may question if it is God. God does not work apart from His word. That is why we should know God's word. In our Going Deeper we discuss ways that God speaks to us today. This week spend time listening for God to speak.

2. Respond Believing

When God speaks, we may experience a "crisis of belief" much like Sarai did. Your thoughts may go to "surely God doesn't want me to do that? We must take the next step and respond believing that God will catch you!

Prayer Time

As a group spend some time in prayer together about the study and about your response to God's direction. Celebrate any answered prayers from last week.

Pray that you come to trust God and take the next step by being obedient to what He is asking of you.
