Discovery Questions

- Has there been a time in your life that you caved to pressure instead of trusting God?
- How can you relate to Abraham in making a mistake and not learning from it?

God loves you so much that if you don't learn the lesson the first time, he will let you learn it again.

- How do you know when you have “learned” the lesson that God wants to teach you? (By not having to learn it again!)

Putting It Into Practice

Each week Pastor Scott will challenge you to put into practice what you are learning. These challenges will help you take the concepts we are learning deeper into your life and help you with your own personal hope. This week Pastor Scott challenges us to:

Times that you face the opportunity to make the right decision; to follow after God's ways and not your own desires we will call crossroads.

1. Prepare for the Crossroad

Often times we don't even know that we are about to have to learn the same lesson again. We need to make the conscious decision that when we are faced with that cross road of "doing the right thing," to choose the correct path. ***This week be aware of any crossroads you may encounter.***

2. Learning the Lesson

When we are at the crossroads and we once again choose our own path over God's path – we haven't learned the lesson. And when you haven't learned the lesson...you get to learn it again until you do. This is a cycle in the life of many Christians. They have not yet grasped the depth of God's love. He does not present the opportunity again to punish you. He offers you the opportunity for you to do the right thing and grow more like his son.

When you come to the crossroad, will you choose to repeat yourself or learn the lesson?

As a group spend some time in prayer together about the study you are doing together. Celebrate any answered prayers from last week.

Pray that God would make you keenly aware of times that your face a crossroad and to bravely go where you have not gone before!
