### **Discovery Questions**

- 1. Do you ever feel invisible, like no one truly sees you or cares what's going on with you?
- 2. Have you felt like even God himself had forgotten you? Perhaps you're feeling that way right now. If so, there is an encouraging word for you in the story of Hagar.

## **Putting It Into Practice**

Each week Pastor Scott will challenge you to put into practice what you are learning. These challenges will help you take the concepts we are learning deeper into your life and help you with your own personal hope. This week Pastor Scott challenges us to:

#### 1. The Victim?

You may feel sorry for Hagar. She was a victim caught up in circumstances beyond her control, and her story may strike you as sad and hopeless. We

may also experience times that we feel like a victim – asking God "why did you allow this to happen." You are NOT a victim. Don't listen to Satan and his attacks.

#### 2. Story of Hope

In fact, however, Hagar is a story of hope, a reminder that whoever we are, wherever we are never invisible to God. Just as Hagar we may experience a time in the desert. Keep moving forward with God. Choose joy.

#### 3. Seeing the Big Picture

We don't often get to see the big picture in life. Step by step as we learn to trust God, during our desert circumstances, we can allow God to do the work. Usually, it is down the road when we can look back and see how God has worked things out for His good. So just because you can't see the entire picture, trust that God is creating a masterpiece for your life. God is faithful!
